



1. (2 Peter 1:3) What do you think it means “God has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness”? How would you list or describe “all things”?
2. Verse four speaks of the “very great promises of God”. What do you think are the promises Peter is referring to? In the space below list some of God’s promises to us. How do they bring strength to you as a believer?
3. What does it mean to you that believers in Christ are “partakers of the divine nature”? (v. 4) In what way do believers have the divine nature of God? What does it not mean?
4. What does it mean “make every effort to supplement...” (v. 5)? How do we go about making this effort. Is it in human strength alone? When was a time you tried to live the Christian life in your strength? How did it go?
5. The text tells us if we are growing in our faith we will be effective in living our lives as followers of Christ. As you evaluate your life, is effective a word which describes you? In what ways are you ineffective?
6. What is the meaning in verse ten of the statement, “for if you practice these qualities you will never fall”. What does it mean “you will never fall”?
7. After completing this study if you have never placed “saving faith in Christ” take some time to talk to God about it. Tell Him you understand your sin separates you from Him. Ask for forgiveness and personally trust Christ’s death and resurrection as the payment for that sin. Then tell God you want to live out your faith on a daily basis. He has provided for you everything you need to have a growing faith. What is one area in which you are asking God to help you grow?
8. What is the main thing God is desirous of you learning from this passage? Why do you think that?
