



Before digging into the questions below it would be good to read Matthew chapter 13. This will give you a bigger picture.

1. After reading the parable of the Sower (Mt. 13:3-9; 18-23) answer the following questions.

Who is the sower?

What is the seed?

Who or what is the field?

Who are the birds?

2. What are four things which can happen to the seed that is sown?

3. What question is Jesus answering in this parable. Remember, keep the big picture in mind.

4. Now read the parable of the Weeds (vv.24-30; 36-43) and identify the following:

Who is the sower of the good seed?

What does the field represent?

Who are the good seeds?

Who is the sower of the evil seeds?

Who are the evil seeds?

5. What question do you think Jesus is answering through this parable?

6. What do you learn from verses 41-43?

7. What do you think Jesus wants us to understand from the parable of the mustard seed? In other words what question is he answering?

8. What are three take-aways you have gleaned from this study?

9. How do these encourage you in your walk with Jesus?
