4. Why do you think Joshua and the men of Israel were so sure of victory at AI? (Joshua 7:2-3)

5. What did Joshua do after Israel was defeated at AI? (Joshua 7:6-9)

6. What was the reason for this defeat? (Joshua 7:11)

7. What did God instruct Joshua to do? (Joshua 7:13)

8. Take some time and review your past actions. Is there anything you have done that has broken your fellowship with God?

What should your response be to any actions of sin you discover?

9. What does God promise us in 1 John 1:9?

10. Read Joshua’s declaration to the nation of Israel in Joshua 24:14-15. In what ways is this true in your life?
